Helping our Frogs



Our native frogs are unlike any others in the world; round rather than slit eyes; hatching straight into a frog instead of tadpoles; no external ear drums; and not croaking regularly like most other frogs.

These frogs first appeared about 200 million years ago, making them as unique as the tuatara, and the most ancient frog species in the world.

A new disease, the Chytrid fungus, is threatening these already endangered animals. To stop it from spreading never buy, collect or keep frogs at home or school. Don't ever release them into the wild. If you go to a lake, river or stream make sure you Check, Clean, Dry before you leave.
